ORDINANCE NO. 2012-27

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, CHAPTER 17, ARTICLE III. SANITARY SEWERS, SECTION 17-34, RELATING TO COMMERCIAL HAULING FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Phenix City, Chapter 17, ARTICLE III. Sanitary Sewers, Section 17-34 relating to Commercial Hauling Fees, be amended as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

If any part of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional, it should not automatically void the remaining sections.

ARTICLE III. SANITARY SEWERS

**SCHEDULE OF WATER SERVICE RATES
AND REGULATIONS OF
THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA**

SECTION 17-34 – COMMERCIAL HAULING FEES

1. An annual permit fee of \$150.00 shall be paid for all commercial haulers.
2. Commercial haulers shall pay a dumping fee per gallon of septic water dumped based on the haulers manifest (manifest form provided by the Phenix City Utilities Department).
 - 2.1. \$0.025 per gallon Septic generated inside the County
 - 2.2. \$0.050 per gallon Septic generated outside the County
3. Commercial haulers shall pay a dumping fee per gallon of grease dumped based on the haulers manifest (manifest form provided by Phenix City Utilities Department). When grease is dumped in combination with septic water the grease charge shall be prorated based on the grease content of the discharge.
 - 3.1 \$0.04 per gallon Grease generated inside the County
 - 3.2 \$0.08 per gallon Grease generated outside the County
4. All dumping charges shall be paid within 30 days of billing. Failure to pay all dumping charges when due shall result in revocation of dumping permit.
