

RESOLUTION NO. 2013- 327

Amendment to Resolution No. 2012-394

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Phenix City, Alabama, did approve Resolution No. 2012-394 on November 6, 2012, regarding the limiting of city services to the corporate limits of the Phenix City; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Council to amend the policy set forth in said resolution as outlined below:

Exception may be made upon approval by the City Council for water services for single family residences located within five hundred (500) feet of an existing city water main or lateral under the following conditions.

1. Property owner must pay all fees and charges due per then existing water rate ordinance prior to service being connected.
2. Property owner is responsible for obtaining at his or her sole expense any and all easements required for construction of the service line.
3. Service line must be constructed to meet existing City standards then in place.
4. All service line construction and connections must be inspected by the City of Phenix City Utilities Department prior to service being activated.
5. Service line must be constructed outside traveling surface of the road right-of way.
6. Property owner is responsible for any and all required maintenance or replacement of the service line in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Phenix City, Alabama that the Amendment to Resolution 2012-394, as set out above, is hereby accepted and approved by the City Council.
