

Summary of Phenix City Work Session Meeting

Phenix City Council met for a Work Session at 3:00 pm, EST, on Monday, November 30, 2020 via the teleconference platform Zoom. The following items were discussed:

Ms. Emily Riley addressed council regarding the installation of speed bumps on 13th Street behind Hardees Restaurant. She also asked if the street could be closed to through traffic. Mayor Lowe advised the street cannot be shut off and that speed bumps cannot be placed on a city street. Chief Smith advised there will be a greater police presence in that area and more tickets will be given to speeders. He also advised he will conduct a traffic count.
