RE: **Annual Transportation Plan Report**

On March 12, 2019, the Alabama Legislature passed House Bill 2 which levied an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel (10 Cent Gas tax). This additional tax is to be used for maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and bridges that are maintained by the City. The Bill further stipulates that the City Engineer shall provide a written report detailing expenditures made from these monies during the previous year and include the status of the projects shown in the Annual Transportation Plan.

The City has received \$185,151.19 from the additional 10 Cent Gas tax in 2020. The City plans to rehabilitate/resurface Dobbs Drive for a total estimated cost of \$500,000 which includes \$185,151.19 of 2020 10 Cent Gas tax, \$141,067 of 2019 10 Cent Gas tax and \$207,485 of existing gas tax funds. To date, no 10 Cent Gas Tax funds have been expended and the Dobbs Drive Project has not begun.
