RE: **Annual Transportation Plan Report**

On March 12, 2019, the Alabama Legislature passed House Bill 2 which levied an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel (10 Cent Gas tax). This additional tax is to be used for maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and bridges that are maintained by the City. The Bill further stipulates that the City Engineer shall provide a written report detailing expenditures made from these monies during the previous year and include the status of the projects shown in the Annual Transportation Plan.

As of August 10, 2022, there is a balance of \$527,255.89 in the 10 cent Gas Tax account. It is estimated that the City will receive \$218,403.00 from the additional ten (10) Cent Gas Tax in FY 2022/23. To date, the City has expended \$20,598.25 in Preliminary Engineering costs for Project No. STPPC-5721(250) Resurfacing Various Streets in Phenix City and Project No. STPPC-5717(252) Replace the Bridge over Cochagalechee Creek on Seale Road. In addition to these two projects, the Resufacing of Opelika Rd. from US Hwy 280/431N to the City Limits will be added for the FY 2022-23 budget. The total estimated costs of Preliminary Engineering and Construction for these respective projects total \$568,500.00.

The City will utilize the \$527,255.89 available in the FY 2022/23 budget to offset these estimated costs for the aforementioned projects. I have attached information provided by Finance to be included in the report.
