RESOLUTION NO. 2023- 152

WHEREAS, the 2019 Alabama Legislature has passed House Bill 2 (HB2) which levied an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Phenix City will receive a portion of said tax which will be deposited into a separate fund; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be solely dedicated to the maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads as mandated by House Bill 2 (HB2); and

WHEREAS, the City will adopt an Annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31, 2023 and will implement during the next fiscal year based on an estimate of revenues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Phenix City, Alabama intends to utilize funding from HB2 for Preliminary Engineering activities associated with the Resurfacing of Opelika Rd. from US Hwy 280/431N to the City Limits, Resurfacing of 4th Ave from 16th Street to Idle Hour Drive and the overrun on Project No. ACAABRZ59582-ATRP(011). The City's total obligation for Preliminary Engineering and project overrun for these respective projects totals \$518,538.84. The City will utilize \$527,896.68 of available gas tax funds to offset these project costs.
