

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX DURING FEBRUARY, 2024, AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2012-256, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS TAX HOLIDAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: In conformity with the provisions Act 2012-256 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2012 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales and Use Tax Holiday, the City of Phenix City, Alabama, exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, February 23, 2024 and ending at twelve midnight Sunday, February 25, 2024.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2012-256.


SECTION 3: The City Clerk of the City of Phenix City, Alabama is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Phenix City, Alabama and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.


SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective upon publication in The Citizen of East Alabama.
