Chairman Sims called the meeting to order and asked Secretary Phillips-Wyatt to call the roll. Upon roll call, the following members answered present: Member Carr, Member Davis, Member Ivy, Member Lindsey, Member McKissic, Chairman Sims, Vice Chairman Taylor and Member Phillips-Wyatt. Member Green was not present.

The second item on the agenda was the approval of the agenda. Chairman Sims asked if there was a motion to approve the agenda. Member Ivy made the motion to approve, seconded by Member McKissic. 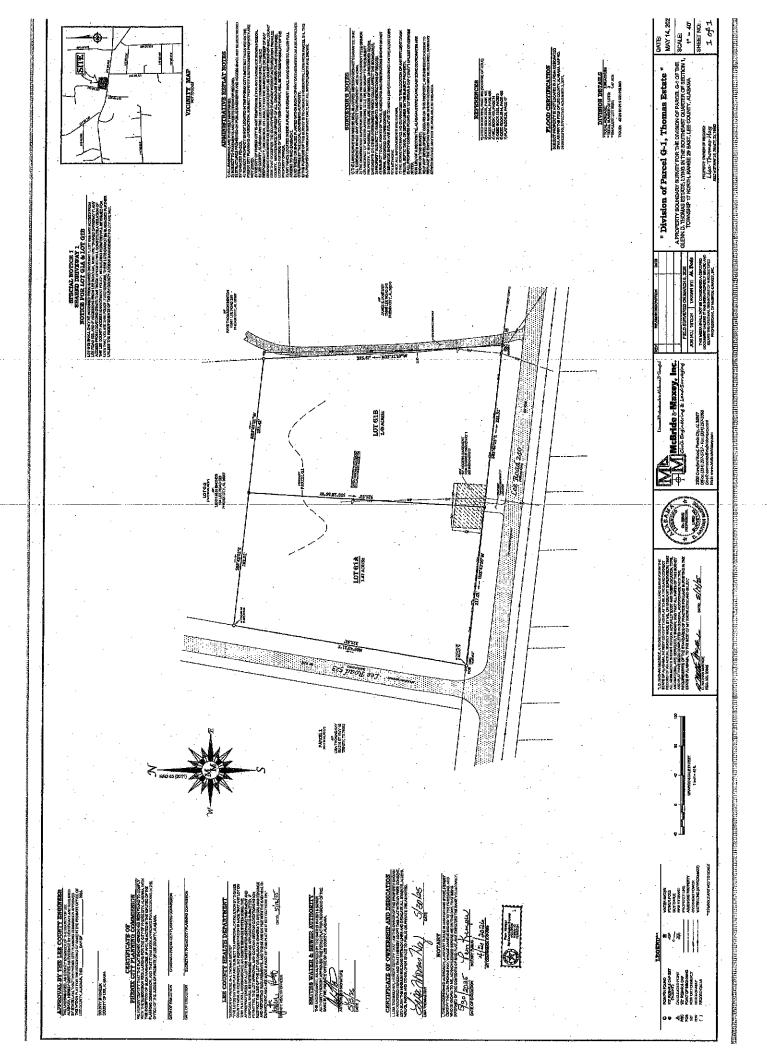
