August 12, 2025

The Planning Commission of the City of Phenix City, Alabama met on Tuesday, August 12, 2025, at 5:15 PM EST in the Council Chambers at the Public Safety Building located at 1111 Broad Street, Phenix City, Alabama.

Chairman Sims called the meeting to order and asked Secretary Phillips-Wyatt to call the roll. Upon roll call, the following members answered present: Member Carr, Member Davis, Member Ivy, Member McKissic, Chairman Sims, Vice Chairman Taylor and Member Phillips-Wyatt. Members Green, Lindsey and Vice Chairman Taylor were not present.

Vice Chairman Taylor arrived at 5:16pm EST.

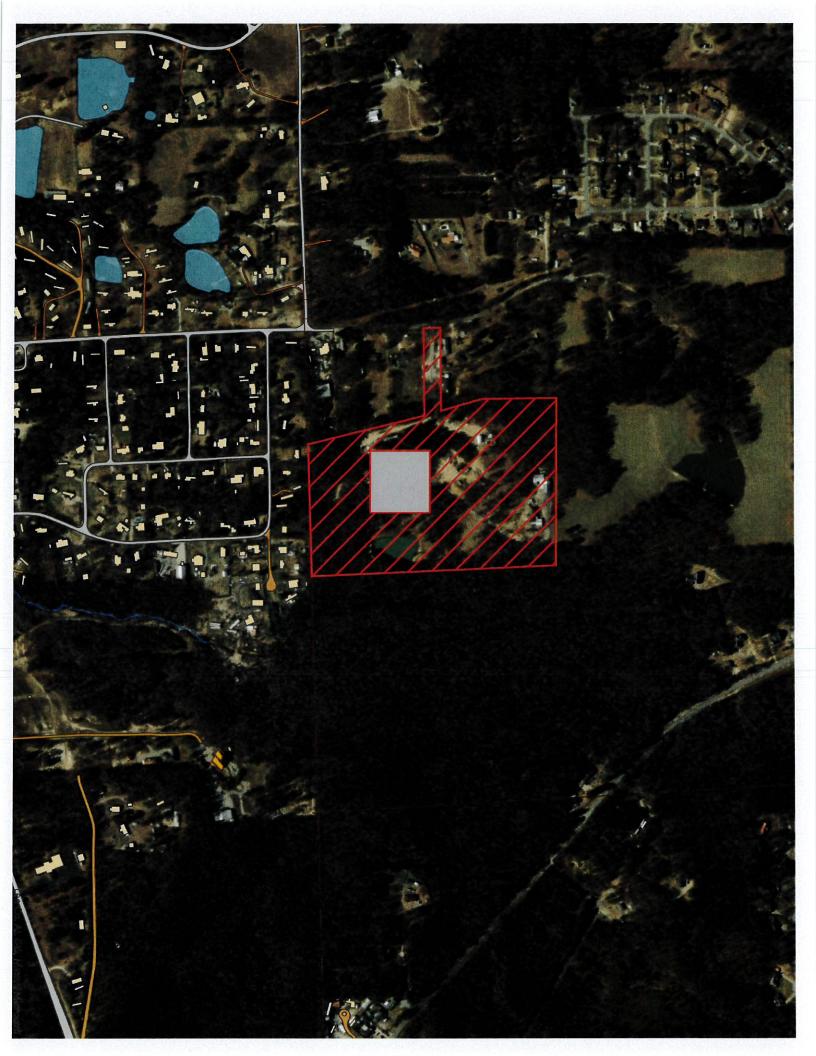

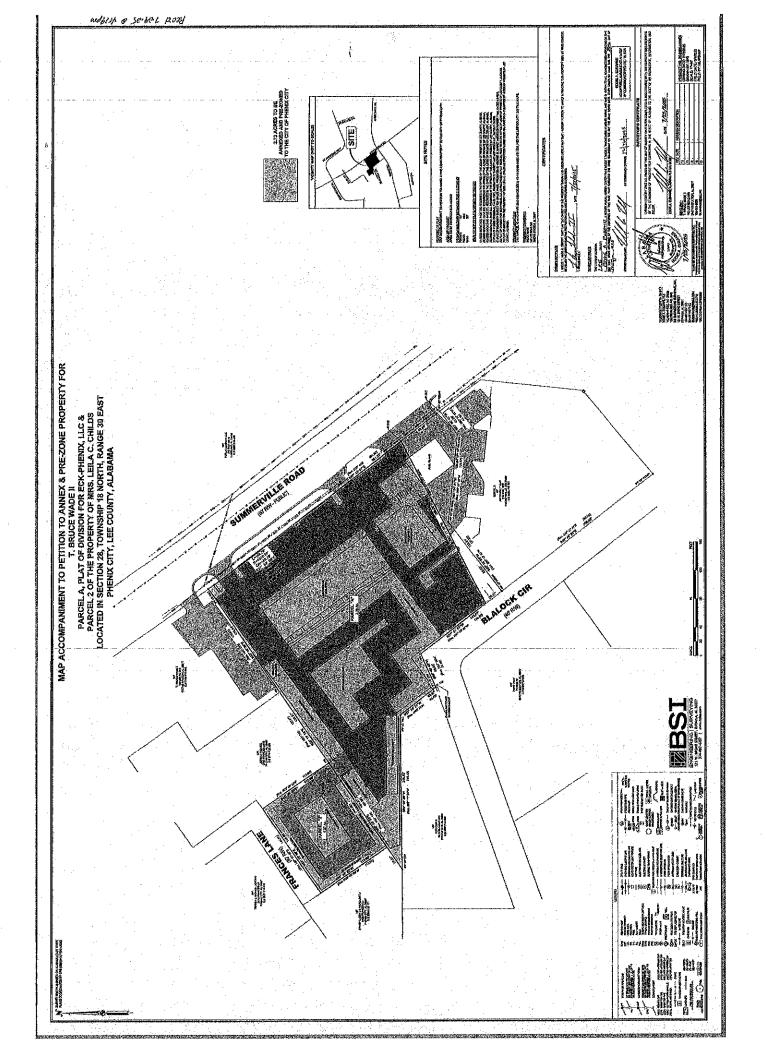
